Polar Circle Air-Cruise

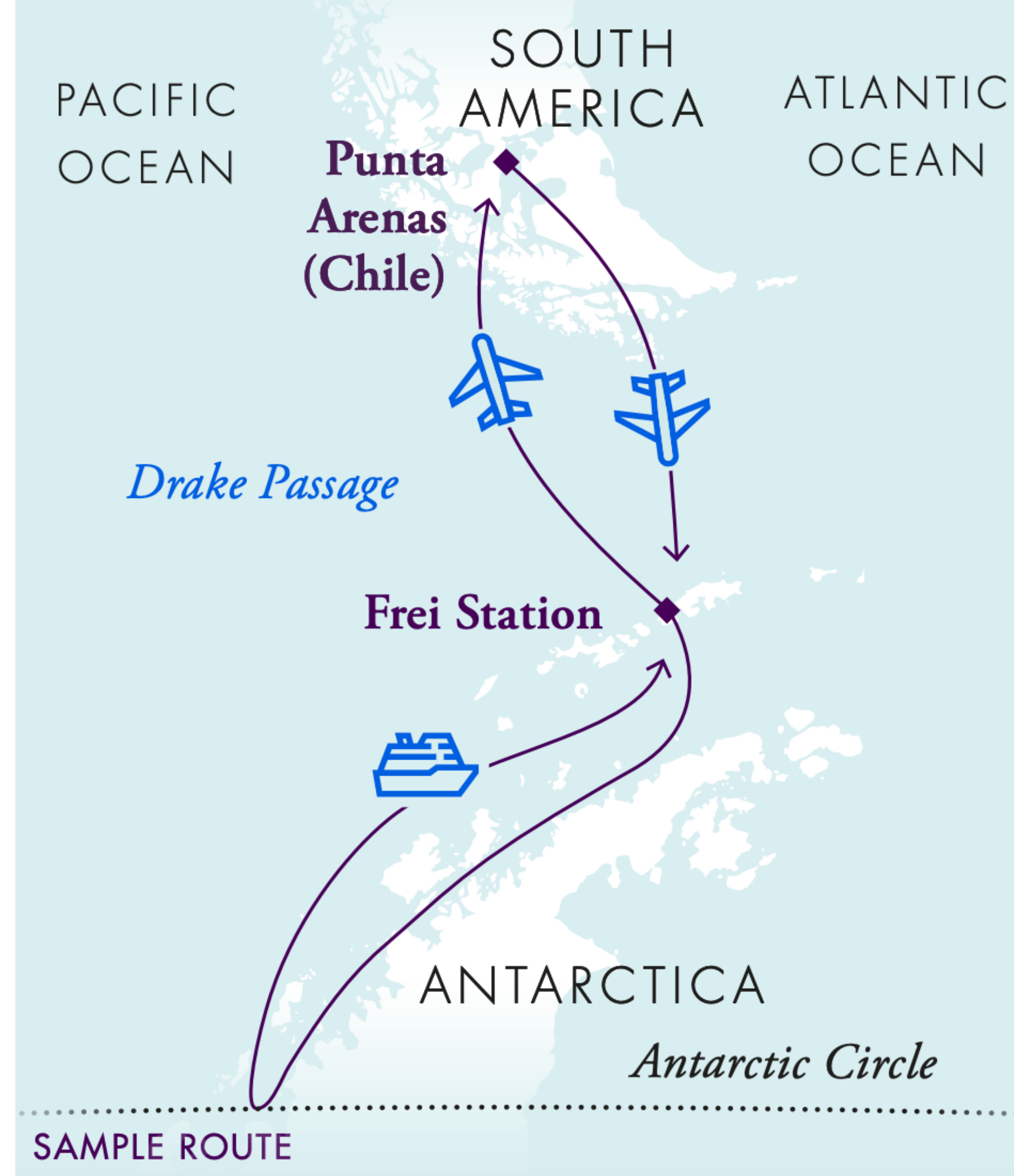

Your Antarctic Ship: Ocean Nova

A sturdy and nimble expedition vessel, with an ice-strengthened hull perfect for Antarctic expeditions. Enjoy a boutique and comfortable adventure with a maximum of 67 guests.

The ship's outside cabins offer three categories of accommodation: dedicated Single Cabins, Twin Cabins, and Triple Cabins. All cabins feature a picture window, a writing desk with chair, a wardrobe, individually controlled heating system, and a private bathroom with shower.

In addition to a glass-enclosed observation lounge and presentation room, Ocean Nova also has a spacious dining room, a bar, a library, a small gym, and an infirmary. The ship has a fleet of 7 Zodiac boats that are well suited for disembarking and wildlife watching.
